
## **Temp-Limiter**<sup>™</sup>

## Installation Instructions Models TL-75 (Cooling)




The internal limiter prevents space temperatures from dropping below 75° F regardless how low the thermostat is set in the cooling mode. Control accuracy is +/-2° F. *Temp-Limiter*™ is designed to be wired between the room thermostat and the HVAC system.



## WIRING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Turn off power to HVAC system.
- Remove self-latching cover from Temp-Limiter™
   and locate mounting plate 4" to 6" away from
   thermostat. Mark and drill holes for mounting
   screws and wire access. (see Figure 1)
   NOTE: Make sure there is no wall stud between
   thermostat and Temp-Limiter™.
- 3. Remove the room thermostat cover to access wiring terminals.
- Fish a one-foot length of 18-2 thermostat wire between the Temp-Limiter<sup>™</sup> and the thermostat. (see Figure 2)
- Remove the wire from the 'Y' terminal on the thermostat and attach it to one of the wires leading to the Temp-Limiter™ with provided wire nut.
- 6. Attach the other wire from the Temp-Limiter<sup>™</sup> to the 'Y' terminal.
