


Fig. 1 Cabin air filter replacement

- 1. Place the windshield wipers in the up position by turning the ignition switch Off when the wipers reach the desired position.
- 2. Open the hood.
- 3. Lift the right side of the rear hood seal from the flange in the area of the right air inlet grille.
- 4. Using a suitable door trim panel pad clip remover, disengage the right air inlet grille retaining clips, then remove the right inlet grille.
- 5. Remove the cabin air filter element, Fig. 1
- 6. Install the new cabin air filter.
- 7. Install the right air inlet grille. Ensure the retaining clips are securely engaged.
- 8. Install the rear hood seal onto the flange.
- 9. Close the hood and return the windshield wipers to the park position.
