Recommended Replacement Interval: 15,000 miles under normal operating conditions.

Installation Time: 5 min

Tools needed: No

Location: Behind the glove compartment

- 1. Open glove compartment and push inwards on retaining latches to remove.
- 2. Remove black retainer string which is attached to the glove box.
- 3. Glove box can now swing down and stay open.
- 4. Once the glove box is down, the filter access door will be visible.
- 5. Push on 2 retaining tabs on each side to release the filter access door.
- 6. Slide filter frame out of compartment.
- 7. Replace filter with the flow arrows pointing down and slide back into compartment.
- 8. Reassemble in reverse order.

Note: For those models that do not have a factory equipped cabin air filter, remove the empty frame and replace with new filter
