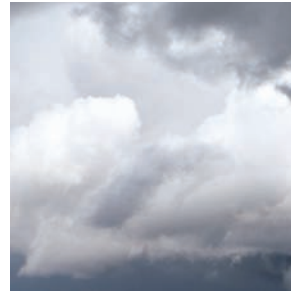
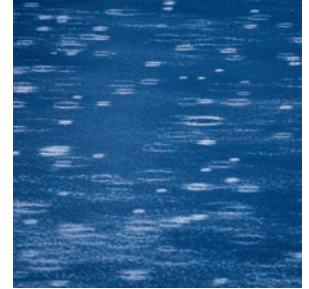

You need central dehumidification more often than you think.

It's easy to identify those hot and sticky days when your home would be unbearable without a central air conditioner. But there are also key times of the year when humidity levels are high enough to make you feel uncomfortable even at moderate temperatures, when the air conditioning isn't running:

- **Spring and Autumn when daytime temperatures aren't warm enough to turn on the air conditioning**
- **Nighttime and morning hours when temperatures drop and your air conditioner doesn't run**
- **Rainy and cloudy days**

Depending upon where you live, these conditions could exist at least 20% of the time in a year. **In many locations it's up to 40% of the time.**



That means you could feel uncomfortable and be subject to all the negative effects of high humidity for over 156 days a year!

A central dehumidifier works independently from your central air conditioner to control excess moisture on days that don't require cooling. It also works in conjunction with your central air conditioner to provide complete

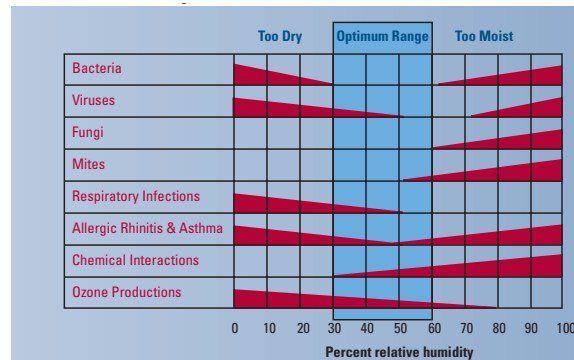

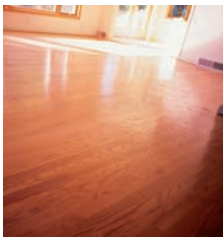
2 Safeguard your family's health.

Air conditioning works great for handling heat— But what about humidity?

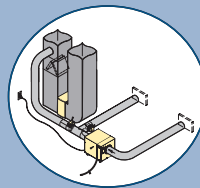
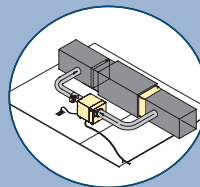
