INSTRUCTIONS

READ ALL DIRECTIONS, MSDS AND WARNINGS ON LABEL BEFORE USING

• Drop HUMIDEX TABLETS[™] into water reservoir.

- Use dosage recommended in table.
- Rinse out precipitated lime solids and silt before each application of tablets.

In **Portable Humidifiers** with water reservoirs of at least 7 gallons capacity, an entire season's treatment may be applied at once.

Full control is normally achieved by these doses. In exceptional cases double the dosage.

In Vaporizers, put one tablet in water with each use.

For each 10 gallons of water evaporated per day:

Water Hardness	<u># Tablets</u>	Frequency
Soft – Medium (up to 10 grains)	2	Every 3 months
Medium – Hard (up to 20 grains)	2	Every 1 ½ months
Hard (up to 30 grains)	2	Every month

Keep container sealed to avoid swelling of tablets
