Traffic Stop and Park Search

I have used the GL4 for 2 nights at work. I have used the 550 lumen lamp with primary cells provided.

First I used it on a traffic stop with a vehicle occupied by three persons.

Upon approaching the vehicle I used the GL4 to illuminate the vehicle and passengers. The reaction was immediate and noticeable. The passengers became slightly agitated and very compliant. All of them paid strict attention to me. None of them were acting in any manner that would cause me to draw attention to any individual. It is difficult to articulate but there was a level of compliance that was different than most encounters at night using a standard type of hand held flashlight. I was definitely impressed by the performance of the 550 lumen lamp.

Next there was a call in a park in reference to a disturbance. Several of us responded. The parks here are huge and densely wooded. The parks are several square miles in size. Most of my Co-workers were using smaller hand held lights like the Streamlight Stinger. They are fine for illuminating a pathway. When I lit up the GL4 it was a major difference. Several of the deputies stopped and turned to look at where the light was coming from. The GL4 was able to illuminate areas of the park that other lights just couldn't touch. It burned through foliage allowing us to see peripheral areas that were otherwise dark even when directly illuminated by lesser lights. The performance of this light is incredible.
