
Temp-Limiter[™]

Installation Instructions Models TL-70H and TL-73H




The internal limiter prevents space temperatures from exceeding 73° F (Model TL-73H) or 70° F (Model TL-70H) regardless how high the thermostat is set. Control accuracy is +/- 2° F. *Temp-Limiter*™ is designed to be wired between the room thermostat and the furnace.



WIRING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Turn off power to furnace.
- Remove self-latching cover from Temp-Limiter™
 and locate mounting plate 4" to 6" away from
 thermostat. Mark and drill holes for mounting
 screws and wire access. (see Figure 1)
 NOTE: Make sure there is no wall stud between
 thermostat and Temp-Limiter™.
- 3. Remove the room thermostat cover to access wiring terminals.
- Fish a one-foot length of 18-2 thermostat wire between the Temp-Limiter[™] and the thermostat. (see Figure 2)
- Remove the wire from the 'W' terminal on the thermostat and attach it to one of the wires leading to the Temp-Limiter™ with provided wire nut.
- 6. Attach the other wire from the Temp-Limiter[™] to the 'W' terminal.
